What is Canva?

- Canva is an easy-to-use online platform where you can create your own designs.
- It offers a variety of templates including movie posters.
- Ideal for beginners, No design skills needed.
- Drag-n-Drop editor: Offers simplicity and efficiency




Sign Up for a Free Account

What do you need to get started?


- Computer, Tablet, or Phone
- Access to Internet
- Email Address

Sign Up for Canva Account




- 1. Go to www.canva.com and select Sign up.
- 2. From the signup page, choose to Continue with email or Sign up with work email.

Sign Up for Canva Account




- 3. **Enter** the email address you'd like to use in Canva, then **select Continue**.
- 4. **Enter** your preferred account name.

Sign Up for Canva Account




- 5. Click Create your account.
- 6. **Enter** the code that was sent to your email address to finish signing up.

Sign Up for Canva Account Cont'd.




- 7. You can set a password in Settings later.
- 8. **Verify** your email address by following the steps in the email sent.

- 9. **Enter** the confirmation code from the email you received.
- 10. Now watch the demonstration.





Canva Editor - Toolbar

The Toolbar is dynamic and changes based on your actions in the work area.

- Text
- Animate
- Copy Style
- Format
- Group/Ungroup
- Effects
- Position
- Transparency

Toolbar



1 Text

Choose font and adjust font size, color, and formatting

4 Animate

Options for animating elements

Copy style

Apply the style and formatting of elements and text across your design

10 Lock / Unlock

Lock elements so users cannot change them

2 Format

Adjust alignment, add lists, and adjust spacing

5 Group / Ungroup

Group selected elements

8 Transparency

Adjust element transparency

3 Effects

Make your text pop with text effects

6 Position

Arrange elements and view, manage, and customize all of the layers in your design in one place

9 Links


Link to websites or other designs

Canva Editor - Floating Toolbar

The Floating Toolbar appears as needed in your work area.

- Copy/Copy Style/Paste
- Duplicate
- Delete
- Align to Page
- Alterntative Text
- Rotate
- More

Floating toolbar



Copy / Copy Style /
Paste

Copy and paste elements

2 Duplicate

Duplicate selected elements

3 Delete

Remove selected elements

4 Layer

Move elements backwards, forwards, to the front, or the back

5 Align to page

Align and organize elements

6 Comment

Add comments for collaborators or later reference

7 Alternative Text

Describe your designs with Alternative Text 8 Add to all pages

Apply an element to all pages of your design

9 More

More options

10 Rotate

Rotate elements

11 Move

Move elements
