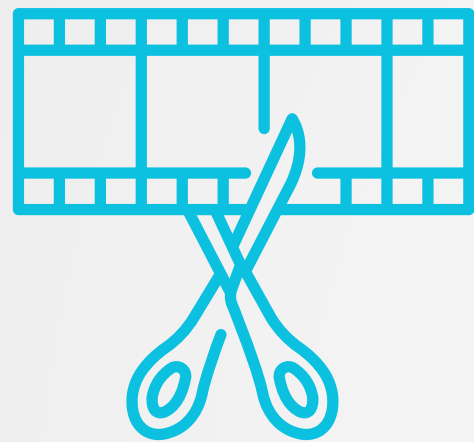

1. **Log in** and select template.
2. **Add** Elements - shapes, icons, videos, lines
3. **Upload** images/videos or use images/videos in elements
4. **Move** elements to Root Folder
5. **Add** Text and customize
6. **Change** backgrounds
